Month: June – Imagine life for those that struggle

Children who find communication hard, find life hard. Over 1 million children in the UK struggle to communicate.

This is an exciting time of the year for sports fans. With the end of term coming up and many schools planning sports days as well as non-stop sports on television such as the end of the football season, Wimbledon tennis championship and the building anticipation of the 2012 Olympics. It can be very isolating for a child struggling to communicate to not be able to join in such typical child (and adult) banter. This is what has defined our resource this month. Included in this pack are resources to support ALL children in engaging in conversation about the sports they regularly experience.

Pages 2-5: Sports boards: These pages allow pupils to talk about the sports they like or that are taking place right now. Print and use as a communication board or cut up to make flash cards or visual prompts. **Why not try?** Talking about which team you support and the colour of the strip. Looking at a map and seeing where all these places are, how many teams play in London, Manchester and Liverpool? Adding photos from Google images of your favourite sports celebrities?

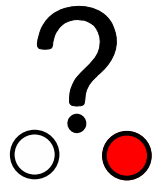
Pages 6-8: Championship story: A brief story about popular championships and when they take place. **Why not try?** Discussing how old you would be when the next Olympics or World Cup takes place?

Page 9: Sportsmanship: A brief definition of sportsmanship. **Why not try?** Extending the conversation to include examples of showing good sportsmanship behaviour?

It is important to think of these resources as a way of including all pupils. If the pupil is included in a mainstream setting, these grids will allow them to chat to their peers.
