24 hour clock – Timetables usually use the **24 hour** clock. This is easy to use when you are used to it:

- 1:00am (when we are asleep) is 01:00 in the 24 hour clock.
- 9:00am (at the beginning of school) is 09:00 in the 24 hour clock.
- 1:00pm (during lunchtime playtime) is 13:00 in the 24 hour clock, because it is 12pm + 1 hour more= 13:00.
- 3:00pm (almost home time) is 15:00 in the 24 hour clock, because it is 12pm + 3 hours more= 15:00

Good afternoon and welcome to sports roundup. It's been another fantastic day of football matches. Here are the team places for the premiership league, as the results come in....

Leeds remain in first place with 41 points. Leicester are at the bottom of the league this week with 16 points. After a thrilling game, Southampton go up to twelfth place with 25 points. Liverpool stay fifth with 38 points. Chelsea are one below Liverpool with 33 points, whilst in ninth place is Aston Villa, with 29 points. Ipswich remain in nineteenth position, with 18 points after a disappointing result in their game with West Ham. West Ham are going up the league with 25 points, they are now in thirteenth position. Manchester United are in second place with 39 points. Newcastle take fourth position this week with 39 points. Middlesborough have 22 points and are now in seventeenth position. One above them is Blackburn, also with 22 points. Arsenal are third this week with 39 points. Charlton have 29 points after a nil-nil draw, leaving them in eighth place in the table. London team Tottenham are in seventh position with 31 points. Fulham are in tenth position with 27 points. Meanwhile Everton are in fourteenth position with 23 points. Derby stay in eighteenth place with 19 points, they aren't playing until Tuesday, so they have a game in hand. Bolton will meet Derby on Tuesday and so they hold fifteenth place with 23 points.
